
S. With reference to your letters of the 26th ultimo respecting the steamers "PRAVDA", "KOUIBISHEV" and the motorship "NEPTESYNDICAT S.S.S.R.", I beg to acquaint you that the cases of these vessels have been under the consideration of the Committee at their meeting to-day, and in view of the intimation that the Owners do not desire to retain the Society's classification for these vessels instructions have been given for the class of each to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

With regard to the "NEPTESYNDICAT S.S.S.R" and "PRAVDA", I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the class of these vessels the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
