Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 31st ultimo respecting damage sustained to the steamer "PRAVDA", which was reported on by the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool recently and referred to in my letter of the 28th ultimo, and have to thank you for your remarks.

I find that when writing you, although the damage referred to consequent on the vessel striking a submerged object in Langsund Fjord in July last related to the port side of the vessel, I should also have mentioned that damage sustained through contact with the ice during the vessel's voyage from Leningrad to Liverpool on the 24th February last also remains to be dealt with, and that damage from this cause was sustained both on the port and starboard sides.
