Motorship "WAZIRISTAN"

With reference to previous correspondence, I have to acquaint you a report has been received of the survey which was held on this ship at Falmouth in October last, from which it is noted an examination was made of the repairs which had previously been effected at Houston in April last.

Further repairs were effected and in accordance with the Surveyors' recommendation, the vessel's class has been continued subject to set in shell plates H.3, K.14 (port side), also J.4. and K.4. etc. (starboard side) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary, and to permanent repairs being effected to centre girder etc. in Nos. 1, 2, 4 and 6 cargo tanks at the Special Survey.

As regards the machinery, the class has been made subject to Nos. 2, 3 and 4 main engine cylinder liners, which were found to be cracked, being specially examined before the end of April, 1954.

A record of docking 10,53 has meanwhile been assigned.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
