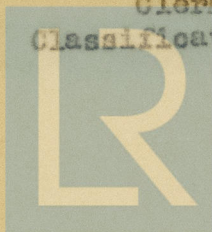
I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are proposed to complete the Special Survey, which became due in May last and was commenced at Montreal during that month.

To complete this survey all Rule requirements remain to be dealt with except:- all holds (except bilges) 'tween decks, engine room D.B. feed water tank p. and s. (internally), deep and peak tanks, decks, casings, hatchways, covers, supports and closing appliances, ventilator coamings and air pipes (tops). O.F. settling tanks p. and s. tested.
