A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 6,61 but postponement until 6,62 was approved 15.3.62. A further postponement until 9,62 was approved 17.8.62, a satisfactory General Examination having been held at Singapore in 7,62.

The class is subject to indented shell plating in way of E.R. store (s.s) and to wasted keel plating in way of frames 25/6 being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking.

ACTION is DEFERRED for a Special Survey.

There is an S.R.L. Appendix item.

The SINGAPORE Surveyors report (9,62) this Tanker examined in drydock and part of the requirements of a Special Survey have been complied with.

On account of wear and tear, extensive recommendations have been made for renewals to shell and deck plating, bulkhead plating and structure in way of cargo tanks.

The Owners have stated that in view of the extensive repairs now considered necessary to place the ship in good condition that they desire no further survey work to be carried out and for the ship's class to be withdrawn - in this connection refer also to Singapore Surveyors letter dated 11.10.62.

In view of the above, IT IS SUBMITTED the Notation of "Class Withdrawn ~~at Singapore~~ Request - 9,62" be inserted in the R.B.
