Dear Mr. Sladden,

I duly received your letter S. of the 21st February 1946 regarding the Electrical Plans for the trawlers "ABY", "BULBY" and "NAVENA" and I regret that my letter of the 19th was not sufficiently clear.

Mr. Connell has endeavoured for months past to obtain from the Electrical Engineers diagrammatic plans of the installations they are requested to fit but so far without result. They continue to state that they are too short of labour and find it difficult to comply with these present requirements.

I have taken this matter up with them and informed them that unless they comply with present Rules, it is probable that the classification of the vessels in which their installations are fitted will be indefinitely withheld until the requirements be complied with.

Messrs. Broady have definitely promised these plans for the above vessels early next week and I have informed them that unless they submit plans before work is commenced, we will be unable to survey their work.

I trust this will have the desired effect.
