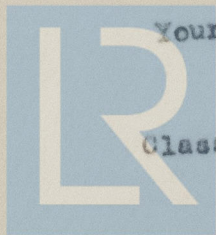
With reference to my classing letter of the 15th instant reporting the classification of the trawlers "ABY", "BULBY" and "NAVENA", I have to draw your attention to the fact that the electrical plans promised in Mr. Connell's letter of the 28th ultimo have not yet come to hand.

The classification of these vessels could not be postponed indefinitely awaiting the arrival of these plans and, while the Committee have now assigned classification meantime, they have asked me to draw special attention to this unsatisfactory state of affairs and to request an explanation as to why these plans were not obtained and forwarded at the time of the commencement of the work as is normally the practice and as required by the Society's Rules for trawlers.
