I duly received your letter of the 12th instant regarding the case of the motor tanker "BARBARA" which was read the Committee today.

They note the attitude being adopted by the Registro Italiano, in which they concur.

Perhaps therefore you will be good enough on behalf of the Society to write to the Owner and inform him that his request for postponement of the Special Survey is premature seeing that this inspection does not become due until December next.

If, however, he is prepared to submit the tanker for general examination as per Circular 1959 about the due date with special attention to outstanding conditions of class, the Committee will be prepared to consider a postponement, the length of which will depend upon the condition of the vessel as found.

I would add that as the R.I. have limited their offer of postponement to six months it is presumed you would think it undesirable that we should offer any more.
