Surveyed the S.S. "FIRST", 243 tons gross of Belfast, on 20th September 1957 as she lay afloat at Kilkeel, and subsequently on 19th October 1957 as she lay afloat in Clarendon Dock, Belfast, in order to carry out examination for postponement of Freeboard repairs for voyage in ballast to Dundee via Caledonian Canal,

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that she be continued as classed without fresh record of Docking and subject to outstanding surveys and repairs being carried out on arrival at Dundee, *being fit to carry* in ballast.
