We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant having reference to our first entry report N^o 1231 on the steamer "Admiral", and in answer have to state, that arrangements have been made with the builders to supply 75 fathoms of 6¹/₂ towline to the vessel as required by Table 22 of the Rules, in place of one of the 60 fathoms of 5¹/₂ noted on our report.
