Dear Sir,

Steamers "CHEPITA" and "CONCHITA"

I have your cablegram of the 5th instant, from which it is noted the new Owners desire to send these vessels to Vancouver under their own steam.

So far as the "CHEPITA" is concerned, the Boiler Survey which became due last December should be held before the vessel leaves your port.

As regards the "CONCHITA", according to the records here this vessel was last seen in drydock in September, 1952, and there is no confirmation of your statement that drydocking took place last December.

On the 30th March the Committee qualified the vessel's class by the assignment of a notation of "laid up - Surveys overdue". If this ship is to proceed as a classed vessel, therefore, it will be necessary for her to be examined in drydock and for the Boiler Survey which became due last September to be held.

A summary of the position has been cabled to you this afternoon.
