This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 7th instant, regarding the above Vessel.

The Owners, as yet, have no record of the H.P. Piston Valve Liner having been examined in Bombay.

However, with regard to the Boiler Survey the Owners' Representative states that the Vessel is due in Charleston towards the end of this month when the Boiler Survey will be carried out.
