Steamer "BALTYK"

A report of survey carried out by the Society's Newcastle-on-Tyne Surveyors between July and October last has been received in this Office, from which it is noted the main circulating pump impeller casing was found to be wasted.

Temporary repairs were effected on this occasion but it is recommended that this casing should be again examined before the end of September next, and the Committee have accordingly continued the vessel's class subject to this matter receiving attention by that time.

Notations of SS Nwc.10,54 and *LMC 10,54, together with records of Docking and Renewal of Screwshaft, with date of 9,54, and sps 10,54 have been assigned. I would add that in view of the fact that this vessel has now been converted to oil burning, the notation of "Fitted for oil fuel 10,54 F.P. above 150°F" is being entered in the Register Book.

Classification Certificates in respect of the Special Survey of the hull and the machinery are enclosed.
