S. I duly received your letter of the 4th instant having reference to the case of the Steamer "CILURNUM", the class of which was expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line in August 1934. The Owner's remarks are noted, and have more than once been the subject of correspondence between this Office and your good-selves.

In this connexion I would refer you to my letters of the 7th December 1934 and the 12th October, 1935 which explain in detail the Society's attitude in the manner of dealing with the vessel's class.

The Owner's further application now forwarded by you would appear to be merely a reiteration of his request which has twice before been refused, and in these circumstances, it can only be repeated that the Committee still see no reason why they should alter their previous decision, and I regret that the record of this vessel must therefore remain unchanged.
