Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 10th April last, returning the form of undertaking, duly completed by you, in respect of the Second Special Survey No.1 of the steamer "CILURNUM", which vessel was at that time laid up at Bilbao, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have again had the case before them today, together with a letter from the Society's Surveyors at that port enclosing one from you dated 23rd ultimo, intimating that you do not desire to retain the Society's classification.

As you are aware the year of grace allowed for the Special Survey expired in March last, and in the circumstances the Committee have now had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
