Dear Sir,

On the 3rd June I sent a reply to your memorandum about the question of the renewal of the auxiliary engine cylinders on the M.S. "CASTLEGATE", stating that the Owners Head Office were considering the matter. To-day I have received a reply from them, a copy of which is enclosed.

I have asked Mr. Reed, the Surveyor who last saw these cylinders, for his views and he says that the engine in question is an old one and it must be remembered that the Owners promised a year ago to renew these cylinders and have not carried out their promise. Our Surveyors have not seen the ship since and although it would probably be in order for a further extension of three months to be granted, he cannot confidently put forward this recommendation.
