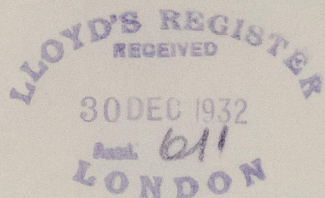


# Lloyd's Register of Shipping.
