We are now in a position, upon the return of our Mr. Hamilton Williams, to answer your letter of the 14th of March relative to the vessel m.t. "SUNNYSIDE".

Following his last visit to your offices and your information by letter that the Gear-box as fitted would not be accepted for classification, investigations were made relative to the purchase and fitting of a new gear-box from Messrs. Modern Wheel Drive.

The price of this gear-box was so expensive, apart from the delivery question which was in the region of one year, that it was not a commercial proposition to fit this new gear-box.


It is therefore with regret that we have to inform you that we will not be proceeding with the classification of this tug.
