With reference to your letter of February 9, regarding surveys on this ship, have now managed to interview Mr. Carney the owner - and somewhat elusive person.

Mr. Carney has never owned a ship before and it was necessary to explain to him purpose of classification and the survey requirements etc. It appears when the ship drydocked at Crown's last June for tailshaft etc., he thought that the complete survey had been dealt with, and it would seem that we are somewhat responsible in that surveyor should have made it clear that the special survey was then due.

However, it has been agreed that next month when stopped for boiler cleaning outstanding survey items including the Boiler survey, but not drydocking, will be with.

You might be good enough to confirm that the survey carried out in June can be ded as commencement of special survey.
