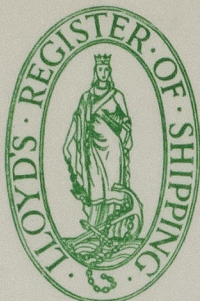


LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

This is to Certify *that I have surveyed the m.s. "MYTONGATE" 410 gross tons of Hull, for examination in drydock with a view to postponement of Special Survey on the 4th March, 1964 and subsequently as she lay both in drydock and afloat at Goole and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be retained as classed without fresh record being fit to proceed to Rotterdam via Immingham and Ipswich, direct from Goole for breaking up or repairs, subject as previously recommended.*
