

# LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

**This is to Certify** *that I have surveyed part of the machinery of the S.S. "OEAkou" 1,933 Gross tons of Dunedin for completion of C.S.M.; M.B.S. and T.S. on the 26th March 1963 and subsequently as the vessel lay in drydock at Port Chalmers and afloat at Dunedin*

*and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following survey records assigned C.S.M. 6/63 M.B.S. 5/63 and T.S. 4/63, subject to the water end of Bilge pump being renewed by 6/64 (12 months).*

Parts now examined:— **PORT MAIN ENGINE:—** H.P. Cylinder, cover piston and rod; valve and gears; Holding down bolts and chocks; Connecting rod, top ends and guides, crankpin and bearings, journals and bearings; Manoeuvring and stop valves.

**STBD MAIN ENGINE:—** Manoeuvring and stop valves, journals and main bearings. Holding down bolts and chocks.

Thrust blocks, shafts and bearings Port & Stbd.  
Intermediate shafts and bearings Port & Stbd.  
Tail shafts Port & Stbd, condensers Main and Auxiliary, Dynamo and driving engine.  
Outboard boiler deed pump; condenser circulating pumps Main and Auxiliary; Independent air pump; Feed water transfer pump;  
Auxiliary feed pump; General service pump; Boiler fuel oil pump (two);  
Bilge pump; Bilge ballast and oil fuel suction lines and controls;  
Pumping arrangements, feed water and boiler fuel heaters; Fire extinguishing appliances; Steering gear; Windlass; Sea connections.
