Steamer "JUPITER"

I am in receipt of your letter of the 2nd June and note that the Owners are now requesting postponement of the Special Survey of this ship until April 1963. Bearing in mind the remarks contained in your Report No.3287, the case has been considered by the Committee today and I am to say that provided a further General Examination is carried out in drydock, in accordance with Circular 1959, they will be agreeable to postponement of the Special Survey, but again the period will depend on the condition of the ship as found and reported, and the extension must not be beyond April 1963.

So far as the machinery is concerned, in addition to the General Examination, the tube stoppers in the starboard boiler should be withdrawn for examination at this General Examination.
