Dear Sir,

The tankers "ESSO BRETAGNE" and "ZANGUEZOUR" were built in 1944 and classed with the American Bureau. Classification with this Society is now desired and part of the necessary survey has been carried out in America in each case. The ships have been purchased by French Owners and the remainder of the classification survey will be carried out at the Chantiers de la Loire, St. Nazaire, towards the middle or end of October. As you know the Society has a Non-Exclusive Surveyor - Mr. Brunelliere - stationed at Nantes but it is desired that an Exclusive Engineer Surveyor and an Electrical Engineer Surveyor should attend for the completion of the surveys.

It is therefore requested that you should, in due course, proceed to St. Nazaire for this purpose. Mr. G. Auterson will attend for the survey of the electrical equipment.


Further information will be given when the exact dates of arrival of the ships are known.
