
I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant regarding the "INGRID THORDEN", and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the scantlings of this ship were examined at the time of the conversion to the shelter deck type with tonnage opening, but were found not suitable for the draught corresponding to the minimum geometric freeboards that could be assigned. The freeboard of 446mm assigned corresponds to the draught for which the scantlings were found suitable.

A copy of the Load Line Computation dated the 27th November, 1936 is sent for your information.
