Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Swedish steamer "INGRID THORDEN" is undergoing alterations while in dry dock at Helsingfors and I think it well to send herewith for your information a copy of a letter which was addressed to the Surveyor at that port yesterday in regard to the freeboards of the vessel, together with his Rpt. C11 for approval of the Authorities whose attention should be called to the scantlings of the beams of No. 1 hatchway on the freeboard deck to the height of the tonnage opening coaming and to the bearing surface of the tonnage opening hatches, as it is considered that these do not comply with the Convention requirements.

At the same time I send herewith a new Swedish Freeboard Certificate in triplicate and I shall be glad if you will forward these, together with the assignment letter, to the Helsingfors Surveyor for issue when the freeboards have been marked and verified and any conditions of assignment required by the Swedish Authorities have been complied with.
