Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th instant regarding the s.s. "INGRID THORDE", and to inform you that your Rpt. C.11, together with A Freeboard Certificate and copy, has been forwarded to the Gothenburg Surveyors for approval of the freeboards by the Authorities, whose attention is being called to the scantlings of the beams of No.1 hatchway on the freeboard deck, to the height of the tonnage opening coaming, and to the bearing surface of the tonnage opening hatches, as it is considered that these do not comply with the Convention requirements.

They have been asked to forward the Certificates to you, together with the assignment letter, for issue when the freeboards, as indicated on the enclosed memorandum, have been marked and verified and any conditions of assignment required by the Swedish Authorities complied with.

If the survey is completed before the Certificates are received from the Gothenburg Surveyors, you should issue a provisional Certificate on Rpt.10, forwarding a copy of the same to the Gothenburg Surveyors and this Office.
