I duly received your letter of the 10th instant respecting the alterations now being carried out to the steamer "INGRID THORDEN", and the case has been carefully looked into.

It is noted that the wells are proposed to be filled in with material having scantlings similar to those already fitted in the ship. The existing arrangements have been investigated, and it is found that the scantlings are not such as would permit of the minimum freeboard for a complete superstructure ship to be assigned, and the permissible reduction from the existing freeboard would be 3".

One copy of the plan is returned herewith and I have to state that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be carried out to your satisfaction, the same will be approved for the amended class, namely, 100A1 with freeboard.

A copy of the C.11 form is enclosed for your information as desired.
