Dear Sir,

Referring to the freeboard assignment letter dated 23rd ultimo and report No. 50058 on the freeboard of the T.S.S. "PRINCESS ELIZABETH", Fairfield's 638, I beg to state that the freeboard will be measured not from the steel superstructure deck, as mentioned in the letter, but from a wood substitute covering on the steel deck $1\frac{3}{4}$ " thick.

A similar remark applies to the freeboard assignment of the sister vessel the "PRINCESS JOAN", referred to in London letter of the 29th ultimo and freeboard report No. 50086.

In view of the above it may be well that amended assignment letters be forwarded to the Builders so that the freeboards may be correctly marked on the ships' sides.

The approved plan of midship section is enclosed for reference.
