We forward for your attention copies of the manufacturers' Works Test Certificates related to the four electric generators installed in the above vessels. These certificates have been produced after considerable delay on the part of the makers, The Lancashire Dynamo & Crypto, Ltd., and in spite of assurances to the Dockyard installing these machines that they would be in compliance with the Rules, it is now apparent that they do not meet with the requirement that under full load conditions the voltage across the fields must not exceed 86% of the generated voltage. The manufacturers state that in this respect they have been supplied to normal commercial requirements, and the voltage across the fields is in the order of 98% for generators Nos. 33N026/7 and 94½% for generators Nos. 33N028/9.

These two vessels are now in service in New Guinea, and we would be glad to have your advice regarding procedure to be adopted in these circumstances.
