Some little time ago the S.S. "KURLAND" bought by The Dollar Co. and reconditioned and classed us at Leith, a freeboard being assigned.

The Agent for the Owners here has informed that the S.S. "VOGTLAND", a sister ship to the "KURLAND", been bought by, I think, by The Federal Line and is being classed with us but that the freeboard assigned in the latter corresponds to a deadweight of 1,600 tons in excess of obtained in the "KURLAND". I should be much obliged if you could write me, for my own information, the facts in regard to the latter case; no doubt you will be able to explain the difference if the Owners' information is correct.
