I acknowledge your letter of the 7th January and note that the ship is now laid up.

In these circumstances there will be no objection to the postponement of the Special Survey, but before the ship is again placed in commission it will be necessary for the requirements of a General Examination in accordance with Circular 1959 to be complied with, with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey until some time before the end of January 1964.

I may add that the Continuous Survey of the machinery should be advanced by the examination of the following parts if such General Examination is held:-

- Main engine attached lubricating oil pump
- General service pump
- Lubricating oil cooler
- Electrical equipment
- One main air receiver
- Steering machinery
- Fire extinguishing arrangements
- Pumping arrangements to be tried under working conditions
- Main engines to be tried under working conditions
