With reference to your letter dated 28th June, 1963 in connection with our Report No. 62027 on the above named ship, we have to advise that for assignment of a full Special Survey it will be necessary to test the fore and aft peak tanks, examine the masts and rigging and drill test the shell plating as considered necessary.

In our opinion it will be necessary to effect further repairs to the plating at the bridge front bulkhead and deckhouse on R.Q. Deck and to side framing in the buoyancy space, at the full Special Survey.

The Owners stated that they did not want the class extended further than July, 1964.

If the Committee are agreeable to grant the postponement of the Special Survey on the portion of survey now carried out we shall be agreeable to have the survey considered as a General Examination.
