The SOUTHAMPTON Surveyors report (7,56), ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated and the requirements of a SPECIAL SURVEY (C), due 3,56, partly complied with.

Minor wear and tear repairs effected.

A number of repairs have been recommended but not carried out.

The Surveyors further report ship has been sold and towed away to a Dutch port.

As the year of grace expired 3,57 and the Special Survey is not yet complete the case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
