M. With reference to Mr. Engledow's letter of the 26th ultimo, ~~dated~~ from Lisbon, respecting the case of the steamer "AMARANTE" and to my telegram and letter of the 3rd instant addressed to him at that port, it is observed that in the last paragraph of Mr. Engledow's letter he enquires if a first entry report on the ship is still required in view of the plans having been approved, and in reply thereto I have to state that as the vessel has never been classed with this Society, and the survey now being held is for the purpose of first classification, it will be necessary for first entry report forms of both hull and machinery to be completely filled in and forwarded, together with the approved plans upon the completion of the survey.
