
With reference to Mr. Gunner's letter of the 31st ultimo and mine of yesterday regarding the proposed classification of the s.s. "AMARANTE" ex "Wurtenberg", I have to acquaint you that the machinery of this vessel will be accepted for the original working pressure of 14 kgs. per sq.cm. and a notation of LMC (with date), without the distinguishing mark \star , be assigned, provided the machinery be opened out and examined and found in good condition, the sizes of the shafting be such as could be accepted; the boilers be examined throughout, their scantlings be found in accordance with the plan; the furnaces be specially examined and found to show no sign of strain, and the pumping arrangements be in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

Particulars of the main engines and sizes of the shafting, together with a plan of the pumping arrangements, should be forwarded for consideration.

The plan of the boilers is returned herewith.
