Dear Sir,

In furtherance to my letter dated 11th instant regarding the "MARIA CHRISTINA" I have today received the enclosed original letter from Owners. In connection with the "PINHEL" I have been able to again examine No.5 double bottom ballast tank and all that is necessary is cleaning and re-coating. Under the circumstances I submit the Owners statement be accepted knowing quite well it is against their own wishes that the survey has not been completed before this.

The Company has now a fleet of eight vessels viz:  
"COSTEIRO" 685 tons - "SILVA GOUVEIA" 874 tons - "PINHEL" 3100 tons - "MARIA CHRISTINA" 3265 tons - "MELLO" 3900 tons - "GAZA" 4705 tons - "ENHABANE" 5878 tons - "AMARANTE" 7678 tons. all classed with the Society except the "AMARANTE" and I have been advised classification is desired - vessel has not yet been opened up for reconditioning.
