Dear Sirs.

In reply to your classing letter dated 30th April 1957, I beg to inform you as follows:

A report on the oilfired boilers was forwarded together with the other reports.

The numbers you are referring to, are two different Nos, on the same boilers. Boilers Nos. 7511/12, made by Stockton Chemical Engineers and Riley Boilers Ltd, are fitted on board. Nos, 7467/68 are Lloyd's Nos, on these boilers. Due to an oversight, which is regretted, Lloyd's No instead of the Makers' was put in the heading of Rpt.5 a.

A 4" direct suction bilge pipe was fitted to port forward end of the Engine Room, as shown on the plan. It is regretted that this was not made clear in the report.

All Machinery Certificates, even those for pumps, were sent from here at the same time as the reports.
