S. With reference to your letter of the 4th and to our telephone conversation of the 14th instant respecting the twin screw Train Ferry Steamer "CARMEN AVELLANEDA", I beg to acquaint you that the case of this vessel has been submitted for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today and that, in view of your intimation, they have given instructions for her class in the Society's Register Book to be withdrawn and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that, in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
