We wish to refer to recent correspondence in connection with the above vessels and in particular you cable of November 9th, in which a summer moulded draught of 12'-6" is mentioned.

The prospective Owners have now inquired as to the possibility of an increase in the draught specified, and it would appear from the drawing approved in 1938, that should the heavier doublers be fitted, a similar reduction in International Freeboard, as was permitted for Great Lakes service, could be allowed, provided there is no geometric limitation, but we should be glad to receive your comments.

It would be of assistance if copies of the Reports C11 and Comp could be forwarded.
