We thank you for your Memorandum of the 7th of September 1962, (Ref.R.), informing us that the Special Survey becomes due at the end of October 1962, and beg to advise you that we have received information from the Owners that the Ship is expected to be trading in Indonesian waters until about the end of November 1962.

The Owners have requested that the Ship be submitted for a General Examination (about the end of November) with a view to postponing the Special Survey until the end of October 1963 (12 months).

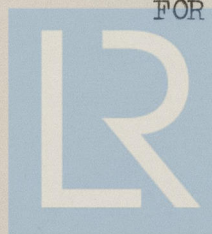
We shall be pleased to learn if you approve of this proposal.
