Dear Sir:-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo with regard to my report No. 430 on the above vessel. In reply I have to state that the pumping arrangements are in accordance with the Rules, and that the Donkey Boiler was tested to one and one half times the working pressure namely 225 lbs. This ratio of hydraulic test pressure to working pressure is the United States Steam-boat Inspection Service Rule requirement in this district and it has been the practice here, during my time with the Society, to apply in the case of Scotch marine boilers test pressures of such proportions. A copy of the plan of bilge pumping arrangement is enclosed herewith.
