We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 681 building by Messrs. Hongkong and Whampoa Dock Co. Ltd for Messrs. Lever's Pacific Plantations Pty. Ltd Sydney, Australia of 350 Tons. Length 125 ft Breadth 25 ft, Depth 10 ft 6 ins intended to be Classed 100 A.1. Under Special Survey

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
