With reference to our recent telephonic conversations respecting the Motorships "ADULIS", "BAHR NEGASH" and "WAL WAL", I have the pleasure to confirm that the amendment of the service limits of the "ADULIS" "For Service in the Mediterranean East of Alexandria, the Red Sea and North East African Coast" has today received approval and after confirmation by the Classification Committee on Friday, the 2nd proximo, instructions will be given for this amendment to be posted in the Register Book.

As you are aware from our previous conversations, the Society's Surveyor at Port Said has been furnished with cabled instructions regarding the issue of a provisional Load Line Certificate valid for three months with present freeboards "For Service in the Red Sea, North East African Coast and to Beirut" in order to cover the present voyage.

On receipt of satisfactory reports from the Surveyors as to the completion of the Classification Surveys and following a satisfactory examination on arrival within the confines of the proposed trading limits, the "BAHR NEGASH" and "WAL WAL" will be recommended to the Committee for the same trading limits, as applicable to the case of the "ADULIS".
