This vessel was built in 1918 and is classed with the Bureau Veritas.

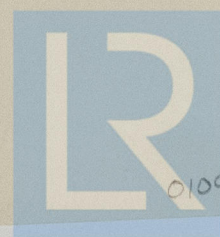
The Cardiff Surveyors now telegraph that they are instructed by the Shamrock Shipping Company to proceed with classification. They understand this has been partly held at Greenock and request to be advised.

To enable this vessel to be classed with this Society, the requirements of the Rules relating to vessels not built under Survey will require to be complied with and a First Entry Report forwarded. A 2nd S.S. No. 3 will require to be held and a Report 8 also furnished.

If plans or drawings showing the scantlings and arrangements of the vessel are available, these should be forwarded for consideration as soon as possible. If such plans are not available, the scantlings and arrangements will require to be ascertained from the ship and fully detailed in the First Entry report, together with all available information as to the origin, size, weight and test of anchors and cables, etc.

It is submitted the Cardiff Surveyors be informed to this effect and that so far no Report has been received from the Greenock Surveyors. The Greenock Surveyors should be advised, and if the Classification Survey has been partly held by them, requested to advise the Cardiff Surveyors as necessary.
