We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, ~~Engines and Boilers~~ <sup>Non-propelling lights</sup> of the Vessel No. 631,632 building by Messrs. The Hong-Kong & Whampoa Dock Co. Ltd. for Messrs. Bruesgaard Kiosterud & Co. Norway of 200 Tons. Length 105'-0" Breadth 24'-0", Depth 10'-6" intended to be Classed 100 A.I.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
