Last Special Survey held in 1941.
Validity of "Examined" notation expired 7.49.
Combustion chambers of both boilers require to be renewed
at Boiler Survey due 7.49.
Load Line Certificate expired 31.8.49.

The case received consideration in July last, when the
Committee agreed to the Load Line Certificate being extended
until the end of October to allow for the new material for
the Boilers to be received at Curacao, provided the Surveyor
was satisfied with the vessels' condition for this period
after examination. The Committee also agreed to the vessel
being submitted to a General Examination in lieu of Special
Survey when withdrawn from service for boiler repairs, with a
view to a further 12 months' service in her present trade.

In reply to enquiry the Owners now state the vessel is
at present laid up at Curacao pending the decision as to her
future employment. They add that when this decision has been
taken the Society will be advised of their intentions.
