I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th instant and in reply I have to inform you that the Committee are agreeable to this vessel's Load Line Certificate being extended until the end of October next to permit time for the new material for the boilers to be received at Curacao for fitting there, provided the Society's Surveyor is satisfied with the vessel's condition for this period after examination.

The Committee are also agreeable to the submission of the vessel to General Examination, in lieu of Special Survey, when she is withdrawn from service for the boiler repairs, with a view to a further twelve months' service in her present trade.

The necessary instructions are being sent to the Society's Surveyor at Curacao.
