On the 30th May last the Owners wrote the future employment of a vessel was under consideration, and they hoped a final decision would be reached within two or three weeks. The present intention was for her to be used at Trinidad as a mobile hulk, in view of which they proposed to submit her for a further General Examination, and would be prepared to have class in future restricted to harbour service at Trinidad, although it would be necessary for her to make an occasional voyage to Curacao for periodical dry docking. They added that new spaces, combustion chambers and tubes had been ordered in the U.K. and should be ready about August, and it was their intention to have her fitted at Curacao.

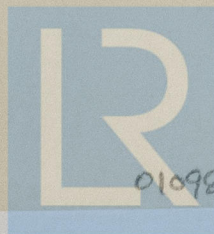
Approval was given by the Committee for continuance of class for the carrying out of a satisfactory General Examination, a suitable restriction then to be made regarding the restricted service.

In reply to enquiry, the Owners state it is hoped a final on will be reached next week regarding the future employment vessel. If it is decided to use the vessel as a mobile hulk, ill probably not retain her in class. There may be a short in the delivery of the new combustion chambers, in which event could appreciate a short extension of class to cover this delay.
