We thank you for your favour of the 25th instant regarding the arrangements made for submitting this vessel for special survey and survey for the renewal of the loadline certificate and in reply would state that the future employment of this ship is at present under consideration and we hope a final decision will be taken during the course of the next two or three months.

For your guidance, however we wish to add the present intention is for her to be used at Trinidad as a mobile hulk and in connection, also in view of her future employment, we are going to submit her for a further general examination for an extension of class and renewal of the freeboard certificate and are prepared, should your surveyor consider it necessary, to have her classification restricted to harbour service at Trinidad, and it will be necessary for her to make an occasional voyage to Curacao for periodical drydocking.

We will, however, communicate with you again when a final decision has been taken in this connection.

In the meantime we wish to advise you that new furnaces, combustion chambers and tubes have been ordered for the boilers in Trinidad, which material should be ready about August next and it is our intention to have same fitted at Curacao.

We trust the Committee will be prepared to defer consideration of this case for a further short period.
