I beg to point out that the period of validity of the "Examined" notation assigned to this vessel will expire at the end of July next. I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for the submission of this vessel to Special Survey and survey for renewal of the Load Line Certificate.

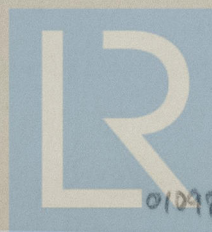
At the same time I have to inform you that in September last the Society's Surveyor at Curacao reported that temporary repairs had been effected to the centrifugal circulating pump, and the vessel's class was continued subject, inter alia, to the circulating pump casing being renewed at the earliest opportunity.

I take the opportunity to point out that the Boiler Survey will become due at the end of July next, and that the combustion chambers of both boilers require to be renewed at that survey.
